Student Agreement/Policy Statement

Check in process: All students and guests attending Grad Night are to report to St. Francis right after graduation (*buses start leaving S.F. at 10:30 pm). No Cell phones, pagers, I-pods, backpacks, wallets, purses, money, and other personal valuables will be allowed into Grad Night. Each student and guest will be checked and searched prior to loading onto buses; if such items are found they will be confiscated and returned after the event. Each student and guest will be given a clear bag to carry their extra clothing.

*Everyone **MUST** use the bus transportation provided to and from Strikes. Buses will return students and guest Thursday, May 27th around 6:30am.

Grad Night is an alcohol, drug and tobacco free party: If you or your guest are in possession of or suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs, you will be denied entry, and will be turned over to the custody of your parents or guardian.

Parking: No overnight parking will be allowed at St. Francis. Students and guest must make arrangements to be dropped off and picked up at St. Francis.

Hypnotist:

A licensed hypnotist has been hired to perform at Grad Night. If you are under the age of 18 on May 26, 2010 and are interested in participating in the hypnotist show, parental approval is required. Participation in the show is strictly voluntary and parental permission does NOT guarantee that you will be selected to participate.
