General Summary

What is the primary purpose of this position?

The Campus Minister for Retreats at St. Francis Catholic High School collaborates with the Campus Ministry Team to foster the spiritual growth and development of the students. This position cultivates student participation in all faith-centered happenings involving the St. Francis community through retreats, liturgical events, and spiritual activities. The Campus Minister for Retreats at St. Francis Catholic High School must be an active, practicing Catholic. This position is a regular, 11-month position.

Essential Responsibilities

All areas of responsibility must be operated consistent with the Catholic mission of the school.

Retreat Program

- Plan, develop, execute, and consistently evaluate the Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Mother-Daughter, and Father-Daughter retreats.
- In collaboration with class moderators and student activities, oversee Freshman Overnight Retreat activities.
- Recruit, train, and supervise the Retreat Team.
- Resource person for planning additional retreat experiences for the school community.

Liturgy and Worship

- Assist the Director of Campus Ministry in all school-wide liturgies and prayer services.
- Oversee the Freshman, Sophomore, and Junior family liturgies; assist with the Senior Baccalaureate Mass.
- Create prayer experiences as requested by the community.

Campus Ministry

- Attend all Campus Ministry Team meetings.
- Attend Back-to-School Night, Open House, Parent Information Nights, and other events to represent and promote the goals of the Campus Ministry Department.
- Participate in other school-required functions, including some evenings and weekends.

Christian Service Program

• Promote the Christian Service Program within the school and community.

- Assist with coordinating St. Francis Day, Advent and Lenten celebrations, Pax et Bonum/Catholic Schools Week, student assemblies, and other calendared and noncalendared community celebrations.
- Encourage collaboration between Campus Ministry projects and school staff.
- Is the liaison between Campus Ministry and the Parent Guild; coordinates hospitality for Campus Ministry events.
- Foster and support an inclusive educational environment.

Student Leaders

- Build relationships with the students, evangelizing and empowering them as young disciples.
- Draw young people to responsible participation in the Catholic faith community's life, mission, and work.
- Foster the total personal and spiritual growth of each young person.
- Develop volunteer and student leadership to assist in carrying out the priorities and programs of the Campus Ministry Department.
- Teach the Ministry Leadership class.

Communication

- Maintain open and active lines of communication within the Campus Ministry Department.
- Provide information for campus publications (homeroom announcements, Principal's Newsletter, The Pax et Bonum Magazine, etc.).
- Create promotional materials for campus ministry programs.
- Communicate with the retreat centers utilized by the sophomore and junior retreat programs.

- Ability to instruct pastorally.
- A deep understanding of the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
- A solid understanding of Renewing the Vision for Catholic Youth Ministry.
- Ability to educate and train in Catholic Social Teaching.
