## FAQ

### What is a scholarship?

Scholarship funds are charitable accounts established at the Foundation for the purpose of assisting students in continuing their education. Some funds are specific to residents of a city or county, others are directed to students interested in specific field of study. They may focus on financial need, academic achievement, academic potential or community service.

### Do I qualify?

Each scholarship fund has specific eligibility criteria defined by the donor. Generally applicants should be a high school graduate, demonstrate financial need, plan to attend an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university, and be a full-time student.

### What is required?

- ✓ Completed application form
- ✓ Personal statement or essay
- ✓ Transcript of grades
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation
- ✓ Copy of Free Application for Federal Student Aid Report

### How do I apply?

1. Determine your eligibility by checking out the requirements on the website
2. Download and complete application and other requirements
3. Submit information by the deadline

The Sacramento Region Community Foundation has awarded almost \$1.5 million in scholarships to eligible students in the Sacramento region.

Annual scholarship awards range from \$500 to \$5,000 and may be used for accredited academic and vocational training.
