

SFHS Transition to Integrated Math

Integrated Math is an intuitive approach to math education, building students' problem solving and application of concepts, which offers a deeper understanding of mathematics. Combining Algebra and Geometry, Integrated Math innovates math education by using physical and literal modeling to explore abstract concepts. Upon completing IM3, students will have learned the same concepts as are traditionally learned through Algebra, Geometry and Algebra 2.

Integrated Math Courses offered in 2019-2020:

Integrated Math 1 Integrated Math 2* Integrated Math 3 or Honors Integrated Math 3* Integrated Math 3A/3B

Note: SFHS will continue to offer Geometry* for incoming students who have completed Algebra 1.
